Harmony Hill, while celebrating our 30th anniversary year, moved forward in significant ways in 2016. This was all made possible by you, our many donors, who gave your generous support so that we could bring our mission to many more people who needed our programs.

Here are just a few highlights of what your support allowed us to do:

- Served 333 individuals in cancer retreats, the heart of our program
- Grew our innovative Health Professional Renewal program substantially, serving 76 providers from 14 different organizations
- Served 244 individuals in six hospitals and clinics in the Puget Sound region through community-based Healing Circle/Cancer Wellness programs
- Reached over 7,000 people in our cancer retreats, offsite programs and webinar/podcasts, a 30% increase over 2015


Please note that our health professional and hospital programs generated earned revenue for Harmony Hill, while allowing us to more broadly serve our mission.


We did all of this while keeping our administrative and fundraising expenses to 21% of our overall expense budget.
